Registration	Registration will be open from 08.00 Archery GB Membership cards will be required for booking in. If you are not yet in possession of a valid card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.
Event Timings	Assembly will be at 09.00 with Practice at 09.15 (Up to 30 Minutes).
Shooting Rules	The tournament will be shot to the Archery GB rules in force at the time of the event.
Dress Regulations	Please refer to Archery GB's rules of shooting for dress regulations (rule 307 will apply). Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
Photography	In line with Archery GB policy, anyone wishing to take video or photographs during the event must register their details with tournament organiser. If parents/carers have any concerns about their child/young person being photographed or filmed, they should notify the organisers. The organisers reserve the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.
Refreshments	Tea, Coffee and a selection of cold drinks will be available for purchase.
Target Bosses	The host club will be utilizing layered foam bosses for as many classes as possible. These will be supplemented by straw bosses as needed.

Special Note	Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an agent to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please contact the organiser for advice.	
Smoking	Smoking is only permitted behind the tent line	
Car Parking	There is limited parking available next to the club house. Parking on the field is possible for archers with disabilities. Parking is also allowed in the main Rural Centre car park.	
General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)	When you enter competitions / shoots, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bowstyle, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info. NCAS CASWELL SERIES INFORMATION

The NCAS CASWELL SERIES will consist of 3 Stage shoots and a Finals shoot.

All the Stage Shoots will be 12 Dozen Rounds.

- Stage 1 – Double WA720, Double Metric122 & Double Metric 80 (4th Sunday in May)
- Stage 2 – WA 1440 & Metric 1 – 5 (4th Sunday in June)
- Stage 3 – York, Hereford & Bristol 1 – 5 (Date TBC)
- The Finals – WA720, Metric122 & Metric 80 Ranking Round & Head-to-Heads (Date TBC)

Eligible Bow Divisions for the NCAS CASWELL SERIES will be: -

- Recurve
- Compound
- Longbow
- Barebow

All bows must comply with the AGB Target Archery Rules of Shooting (Rule 303)

Points for the Stages will be awarded as follows with the top 16 archers in each 50+ and 21+ Class and division invited to the finals: -

For the Junior Age Class Archers, the League Table will be on Gender and Division but **not** split by Age Classes. The top 16 archers from each Division will be invited to The Finals. In The Finals all Junior Age Classes will be competing against each other.



NCAS CASWELL SERIES – THE FINALS

The finals will take place on the 4th Sunday in August. They will consist of a WA720 / Metric122 / Metric80 Ranking Round in the morning with Head-to-Heads in the afternoon to determine the Series Winners.

Entry to the finals will be free of charge.

The Junior Classes and Divisions for The Finals will be: -

- Junior Men Recurve - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Women Recurve - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Men Compound - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Women Compound - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Men Barebow - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Women Barebow - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Men Longbow - (Archers aged 20 and Under)
- Junior Women Longbow - (Archers aged 20 and Under)

THE FINALS HEAD-to-HEADS

The 50+ and 21+Classes will shoot their normal WA720 distances for the Head-to-Heads. All Head-to-Heads will be shot using the Sets System apart from the Compound division who will shoot 15 arrows (Ends of 3 arrows) with the highest total score winning.

- Men & Women (21+) WA 70m (Recurve / Longbow) / WA 50m (Compound / Barebow)
- Men & Women (50+) WA 60m (Recurve / Longbow) / WA 50m (Compound and Barebow)

All Junior Age Class Archers will shoot the Head-to-Heads at 30m but with different size Target Faces to make it a fair and even challenge for all. All Head-to-Heads will be shot using the Sets System apart from the Compound division who will shoot 15 arrows (Ends of 3 arrows) with the highest total score winning.
